



## 1 FULL-TIME PATIENT CARE MANAGER

Provides leadership in the clinical care areas (emergency department, acute care, long-term care, pharmacy and activation department) based on the hospital's mission, vision, goals and objectives. Promotes excellence in patient care and manages the day-to-day operations of the clinical care areas.
